

INTERVET Western Balkans - The internationalization of vocational education and training systems in Western Balkans - is a 3-year pilot project funded by European Commission which aims at creating opportunities for learning mobility in the training centers of Western Balkans and improving the culture of learning mobility in the field of VET. 6 regional partners are involved in the project: Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo, Montenegro, the Republic of North Macedonia and Serbia, as well as 8 partners from EU Member States:

Belgium, the Netherlands, France, Malta, Spain, Slovenia and Poland.

Thanks to INTERVET WB, all participants will have better access to resources related to international training mobility and they will learn more about already existing opportunities. And to do so, the project foresees activities at two levels: on the one hand, the mobility of VET learners and on the other, the competence building of VET staff.

- participation of 36 VET teachers in summer schools with destination: Bologna, Seville, Dordrecht
- ♣ participation of 72 VET teachers and managers in the Thematic Themes organized by EFVET and hosted by: MCAST – The Malta College of Arts, Science & Technology (Malta), ROC Da Vinci College (the Netherlands), SEPR (France)
